Canada Pet Travel Requirements:

- **Traveling to Canada from the United States with your dog is very straightforward. All you will need is a copy of your dog's valid Rabies Certificate.**
- **If your dog's Rabies vaccine will expire while in Canada, we recommend a booster prior to leaving to avoid complications on re-entry into the United States. Additional documentation would then be required (not just the Import Form below).**
- **As of August 1, 2024, the *CDC Dog Import Form* is required to bring your dog into the U.S.**
 - **The form must be completed prior to arrival at the border. This form is completed online. It is free and valid for six months if the dog does not travel to a high-risk Rabies country during that time.**
 - **Once the form has been submitted you will be emailed a receipt. This is what you need to show at the border. You can either print the receipt or show it on your phone or tablet on request.**

- **As of right now there are no legal requirements for Cats entering Canada or returning to the US but we do recommend a valid Rabies certificate.**
